**Eligibility:** The regatta is open to all Soling 1 Meter Class yachts whose owners are current members of AMYA, CRYA or their National Authority, and who are properly registered with the Class. Other entrants may be invited consistent with AMYA guidelines and objectives.

**Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012*, as modified by Appendix E (which applies to R/C Sailing), the Class Rules of the Soling 1 Meter model yacht, including the Victor Soling 1 Meter yacht kit *Assembly Manual*, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

**Location:** Racing will be held at **Painesville Kiwanis Recreation Park, Painesville, OH**. Detailed directions to the event and accommodations information [attached](#).

**Entry- \$30 per yacht:** Entry may be made at the site, Saturday June 12, 2010, between the hours of 9:00 AM and 10:00 AM EDT. Entry Fee includes drinks and 1 cookout dinner and party for skipper; additional guests \$15 each. Bottled water will be provided. Lunches will be available for order at time of registration- \$5 each.

**Sailing Instructions:** Sailing Instructions will be provided to all competitors at Registration.

**Measurement:** boats will be weighed, and spars checked for compliance with Class Rules. Sails will be measured for cloth weight and other [Measurements made for compliance with Class Rules](#).

**Racing format:** The racing will be run using **Heat Management System 2007- HMS 2007**. After seeding races, the competitors will be divided in two fleets, and the regatta will be finished with each Fleet having separate Starts. In event of an odd-number of boats, extra boat is added to A Fleet. The Race Director plans the maximum number of races over the two days, up to 19 races within the time frames of the regatta schedule and weather conditions. 7 Races are the minimum required to constitute the Regatta.

**Scoring:** The regatta will be scored in accordance with the Low Point Scoring system as set forth in Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing. For each SIX Races sailed, one worst (highest points) score will be excluded from each yachts overall score. DSQ, DNF, DNC, etc are eligible to use as excluded scores.

**Prizes:** Prizes will be awarded to the top three finishers in each of A and B Fleets.
